

A Requiem for my late wife

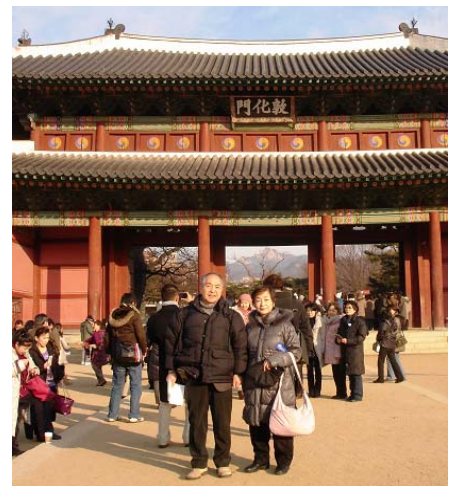
My wife, Shoko, passed away suddenly on Mar.19, 2010 at the age of 65 due to acute heart failure.
